- > Add a few drops of lemon juice and mix
- > Shampoo your hair with your favorite gentle shampoo and rinse
- > Apply the mixture of olive oil, egg, and lemon all over your hair
- > Leave on for five minutes
- > Shampoo your hair again and rinse.

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Her organic olive oil soaps \$5 (which is made simply from Olive oil, coconut & palm oil, distilled water, emollient and glycerin) feels luxurious and never dries out your skin.
